As scientists, we will...

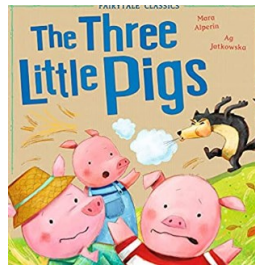
- Identify and name everyday materials.
