As scientists, we will...

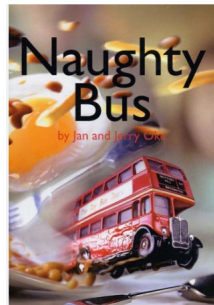
- By observing and discussing changes across the four seasons with a particular focus on spring and summer.
